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COMMON PROBLEMS IN LOGICAL DEVELOPMENT: Hasty Generalization--One example does not "prove" an argument. Avoid using a single quote or an isolated incident as the basis for your argument. Look for additional supporting evidence to buttress your point before proceeding.

COMMON PROBLEMS ...

1. Capitalizing a word that should be lowercase; e.g., "I am the Pastor of the church."
2. Have a clear reason for capitalizing.
2. Boldfacing or underlining words for no apparent reasons.
3. Failing to italicize (rather than underlining) book titles.

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Stylistic Problems. Adapted from John M. Crosset's A Breviary of English Usage. [agr] agreement. Pronouns must agree with their antecedents in number, gender, and person. Wrong Example: I asked everyone whether they knew anyone who wanted to sell their boat. ("They" and "their," which are plural, refer to "everyone" and "anyone," which are singular.)

In translation, stylistic errors should not be confused with linguistic errors, which will incorporate mistakes in spelling, punctuation and grammar. Linguistic errors deviate from accepted rules of language as opposed to the stylistic rules of the company. Stylistic rules are set out in a translation style guide.
