In this technique, white charcoal pencils and regular charcoal pencils are blended together. Light values are drawn using white charcoal, dark values are drawn using regular charcoal, and middle values are drawn by mixing and layering the two. As you can see in the image below, the toned paper does not show through in the drawn areas.

A popular technique with a kneaded eraser in charcoal art is called reductive drawing. In this style of drawing, you are using the eraser to take away the powder and build form. This is great for highlights. To clean a kneaded eraser, simply pull it apart until it returns to its natural gray color.

Use white charcoal pencil. As they say, stars shine only when it ' s deady dark, so is this technique for easy charcoal drawing. As mentioned earlier, this goes with the ' reverse gear technique ' , here when you ' re done with covering white sheet with damn black charcoal stick, you can use white charcoal to draw highlights.

The drawing begins with a loose contour line sketch using a charcoal pencil. Areas of high contrast are noted with a line. Next, powdered charcoal is spread over the drawing and worked into the surface with a mop brush and a paper towel. Darker areas are strengthened with the charcoal pencil. Using a kneaded eraser, highlights are erased out in bulk.

Also charcoal comes in both sticks and pencils and made of powdered charcoal that ' s mixed with clay or resin, then pressed into a stick or pencil core. This medium tends to be darker than even the darkest graphite, so you can get a wide range of values from the whitest white of the paper to extremely dark areas.
