Challenging behaviour is not a learning disability, but people with a disability are more likely to show challenging behaviour. This can be due to people having difficulty communicating and expressing frustrations. Challenging behaviour can also be a sign that something is wrong, like pain or discomfort, that your child cannot express in another way.

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A mental health problem should be considered if a person with learning disabilities shows any changes in behaviour such as loss of skills or needing more prompting to use skills, social withdrawal, irritability, avoidance, agitation, and/or loss of interest in activities they usually enjoy.

A proportion of people with a learning disability will present behaviour that may be considered challenging. In adults this is around 10-15%. What we think of as challenging behaviours can vary, but this often includes aggression, self-injury and destructiveness.

High rates of comorbidity between learning disabilities and challenging behaviors have led researchers to focus on behavioral problems when considering students with LDs (Forness & Kavale, 2001; Mather & Goldstein, 2008). In his book, Challenging Behaviour , Eric Emerson defines challenging behaviour as: ¶Culturally abnormal behaviour (s) of such an intensity, frequency or duration that the physical safety of the person or others is likely to be placed in serious jeopardy, or behaviour which is likely to seriously limit use of, or result in the person being denied access to, ordinary community facilities¶.
