Types of fire extinguisher damage to look out for include: Dents, rusting, scratches or gouges on the cylinder; Excessive dirt; Corrosion and leakage; Clogged nozzle or wand; Frayed or split hose

Most librarians know the importance of disaster preparedness. Many disasters could have been prevented altogether or have had reduced impact if institutions had been better prepared.
