This Handbook is based on the conviction of its editors and contributing authors that understanding and acceptance of, as well as collaboration between religions has essential educational value. The development of this Handbook rests on the further assumption that interreligious education has an important role in elucidating the global demand for human rights, justice, and peace. Interreligious education reveals that the creeds and holy books of the world's religions teach about spiritual systems that reject violence and the individualistic pursuit of economic and political gain, and call their followers to compassion for every human being. The primary aim of the RCIA process is to invite people to become disciples of Jesus and to form them as his followers. *Come and See* was first published in 2004 and this new, revised edition adds significant new features to that original text, including expanded internet resources, brand new sessions, a summary of the Steps and Stages of the RCIA Journey, and much more.
